The successful candidate will require experience of designing and using action research (AR) methodologies, including in community programming, experience of supporting and accompanying staff and partners (including remotely) in developing and using AR tools, in depth understanding of validity and quality assurance in AR approaches, training and facilitation skills, understanding of the challenges faced in project implementation in conflict affected environments
