Job Title: Dairy Manager

Overall Responsibility: The successful applicant will report to the General Manager and head the Dairy Unit. He or She will be responsible for oversight, supervision and performance of designated dairy herd and farm. This include all aspects of high quality animal care, commutating facility repair and maintenance as needed.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Develop a work plan and budget for the dairy herd and present it to the Board for approval
- Proper animal feed resources management including pasture fields
- Ensure steady supply of inputs required for milk production.
- Supervise milking and keep a record of individual animal productivity
- Supervising of workers in all aspects of dairy production including planning for maintenance and repair of farm infrastructure and equipment
- Keep all the essential dairy farm records and make regular analysis of the farm's performance for inclusion in monthly reports.
- Understanding the implications of seasons and make plans for dry season feeding
- Maintain hygiene of the cowshed and ensure good herd health management
- Ensure health and safety standards across the farm estate
- Protect the environment and observe social safeguards
- Plan and oversee marketing of the dairy farm's products
- Perform any other duties allocated to him/her by the General Manager or the Board Chairperson.

Minimum Education and Experience

- Bachelor Degree in Veterinary Medicine or Bachelors of Animal Science from a recognized University.
- Experience in Dairy management or training in the dairy industry not less than two years
- Supervising experience (3 years)
