## PREQUALIFICATION TO OBTAIN A SHORTLIST OF RETIRED PROFESSIONALS IN VARIOUS FIELDS OF THE WATER AND ENVIRONMENT SECTOR THAT WILL RESULT INTO FRAMEWORK CONTRACT

The Ministry of Water and Environment through the Water Resources Institute (WRI) has allocated funds to be used for procurement of retired professionals in various fields of the Water and Environment sector. The entity has developed a strategy paper on how to engage retired professional aimed at benefiting the sector from their knowledge and skills attained over many years in either academia and or in practice. As private sector practitioners retired professionals shall be engaged through 4 core areas of the WRI namely Applied Training, Applied Research, Sector Dialogue and Outreach in order to enhance the capacity and performance of the sector.

The modality of engaging retired professionals involves creating a database of professionals in various fields of the water and environment sector and signing framework contracts with them to provide support to the sector as and when needed. The Individual consultants will be engaged on a rotational basis and in accordance with availability, area of specialization, expertise, experience and target groups to be trained/area of research/outreaches.

### 2.0 Objectives

The objective of prequalifying retired professionals as individual consultants, is to develop a pool of experts, with the requisite capacity to undertake the following: Conducting applied training courses at the WRI, Contributing to applied research conducted through the WRI, Providing short term consultancy services to the sector in specific areas, Mentoring young water professionals and students, Contributing to preparation and review of sector policy and strategy documents, Contributing to developing dialogue documents on topical issues in the sector and organizing the dialogues themselves, Contributing to documenting of sector knowledge and experiences in various fields, General technical support as may be required by the sector.

It is against this background that the MWE/WRI wishes to identify competent retired professionals as Individual Consultants to offer support as and when need arises.

### 3.0 Areas of expertise and qualifications of the retired professionals

The retired professionals will come from a wide range of fields that are relevant to the water and environment sector namely (i) Water Resources Management, (ii) Water Quality Management, (iii) Water Resources Engineering, (iv) Civil Engineering, (v) Sanitation, (vi) Environment Resources Management, (vii) Climate Change, (viii) Agriculture, (ix) Forestry, (x) Business Administration, (xi) Public Administration, (xii) Public Health, (xiii) Social Sciences, (xiv) Development Studies, (xv) Economics, (xvi) Accounting, (xvii) Information technology, (xviii) Law, and (xix) any other fields relevant

to water and environment sector

The Ministry of Water and Environment (MWE) now invites eligible professionals to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested individuals should provide sufficient information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The shortlisting criteria for the professional's capability and experience are;

**Qualification:** A minimum of Bachelor's Degree in any fields of expertise mentioned above, A post graduate qualification in the relevant fields is an added advantage, Experience in the water sector practice, research or training for atleast 10 years, Knowledge of National Water Policy or Water Act and regulations, Environmental Policy, Law, conservation planning, standards and Guidelines is an advantage, Excellent communication skills

**Experience:** The person must have worked for at least 10 years in the water and environment sector under any of the following categories; Policy makers and practitioners (at a level of senior officer and above in government ministries and agencies, development partners, civil society, regional networks and intergovernmental entities, bi-lateral agencies, NGOs, religious and cultural institutions), and/or, Academia from national and international universities, research.

The professionals will be acquired through publication of notice inviting expression of interest and developing a shortlist method set out in the PPDA Regulations, 2014.
